# Code of conduct for students

## St Andrew's Senior School

1. Students are expected to set high standards of honesty, courtesy and respect for others
2. Common sense is to be used both in interpreting the School Rules and in general behaviour.
3. Bullying and theft of any kind are particularly damaging to any community and will be treated severely.
4. The following are not allowed and any infringement may result in suspension or expulsion :
  - Unacceptable sexual intimacy
  - Possession or use of unauthorised drugs – Students may be subject to drug testing
  - Smoking or possession of smoking materials
  - Possession or consumption of alcohol
  - Assault or threatening behaviour
  - Racist abuse
  - Possession or use of fireworks, firearms, knives or other weapons
  - Tampering with any fire appliance or safety device
  - Vandalism or tampering with school, staff or students property
  - Viewing of sexually explicit material in any form
  - Possession of condoms
5. Students are not allowed to enter the boarding houses of members of the opposite sex, except common rooms under staff supervision.
6. Music should never be played at a volume which disturbs others or which contains offensive lyrics.
7. No chewing gum or bubble gum is allowed.
8. No possession of DVDs or computer games where the age restriction is not appropriate.
9. Absence from lessons is a serious matter. Permission to miss a lesson should always be requested – for whatever reason – and work missed should be caught up immediately.
10. Members of the school are expected to be familiar with the following, which are published separately on school/ boarding house notice boards and may alter from time to time:
  - Dress Code
  - Daily Routine, including Prep Rules
  - Fire Drill & Safety Regulations
  - Boarding house code of conduct
  - E-mail and Internet usage
  - Use of Telephones
  - Use of Bicycles
